STATEMENT of FAITH and CHRISTIAN STANDARD of CONDUCT CAMP CHERITH – ONTARIO

All Camp Cherith® – Ontario board, committee members and camp workers serving in any capacity shall be committed to Christ and His service and seek to manifest the kind of life expressed in Romans 12:10-12 "Be devoted to one another with brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves. Never be lacking zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer."

STATEMENT OF FAITH – We believe:

- In one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, Holy Spirit (John 14:16-17, Matt. 28:19)
- Jesus Christ was begotten by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, and is true God and true man (Matt. 1:18-23)
- The Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are verbally inspired by God, inerrant in the original writings, and of supreme and final authority in faith and life. (II Peter 1:20-21, II Timothy 3:16-17)
- That man was created in the image of God; he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death, but also spiritual death which is separation from God; and that all human beings are born in sin and this sinful nature is the origin of all sinful acts in thought, word and deed. (Gen. 1:26, Romans 5:12, Isaiah 59:2, Romans 6:23)
- The Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins, according to the Scriptures, as a representative and substitutionary sacrifice; and that all who believe in Him are justified on the ground of His shed blood. (Romans 5:8-9)
- All who receive in faith the Lord Jesus Christ are born again of the Holy Spirit, and thereby become children of God. (John 1:12, Romans 8:9)
- In the bodily resurrection of Christ and His ascension to heaven, and in His present work as High Priest and Advocate. (I Corinthians 15:3-4, Hebrews 4: 14-16)
- In the personal return of Jesus Christ. (Acts 1:11, I Thessalonians 4: 16-17)
- In the bodily resurrection of the just to everlasting blessedness, and the unjust to everlasting punishment. (Acts 24:15, Revelation 20:15, Romans 6:23)

CHRISTIAN STANDARD OF CONDUCT: (1 TIMOTHY 4:12)

I understand the need to demonstrate the highest standards of a Biblical lifestyle for campers and other staff members. Therefore as long as I am under contract with Camp Cherith – Ontario I agree to abstain from the use of alcohol, tobacco, or any illegal drugs, to guard my speech at all times, to dress modestly, to remove body piercing, and to cover any tattoos that might be considered morally offensive.
